- We will be reading the following text types during topic work:

 - Recounts
- Daily phonics work will be based on Letters and sounds phases 2, 3, 4 & 5 (this depends on the phonics group that each child is in)
- Guided Reading- Children will be heard reading in small groups and do comprehension.



Science

We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.



Geography

Through learning about a famous explorer, we will use atlases and globes to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will also use maps to name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital

Famous People

Each of the subject areas will be taught together within the topic of famous people.

Year 1

Art

Self portraits - By studying the work of famous artists, we will look at images of children in drawings, paintings and photographs. We will investigate a range of materials and techniques and experience mixing colours to create self portraits.



History

We will learn about 19th century significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. Through studying the lives of others in the past, we will learn about similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods.



Numeracy

Count and estimate reliably at least 20 objects; recall number bonds to 10; compare and order numbers - 1 more & 1 less; read and write numbers 0 to 20 and beyond; relate addition to counting on; solving problems; pairs of numbers that total 10; using number line.

PE

Games - finding spaces, beanbag skills, moving on to ball skills.
Dance - exploring movement ideas and creating a dance to a set piece of music.
Gymnastics - use of apparatus and partner work to create sequences.

ICT

Coding - We will learn that giving computer instructions in code is called programming. We will learn how to program objects to do an action.
