



Literacy:

This half term children will be:

- learning to spell more words with contracted forms using apostrophes.
- identifying nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs.
- add suffixes to spell longer words, including -ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly
- becoming increasingly familiar with and retelling a wider range of stories, fairy stories and traditional tales.
- discussing and clarifying the meanings of words, linking new meanings to known vocabulary.
- being introduced to non-fiction books that are structured in different ways.
 - writing for different purposes.
- predicting what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far.
 - performing and writing interviews.

Science- not this half term.

History- not this half term.

Art and Design:

Brazilian carnival costumes, looking at designs and how they are made. To use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.

Geography:

Contrasting to the UK

We will be looking at geographical similarities and differences, by studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom and Brazil.

We will learn to use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key features including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.

Computing:

'We are Researchers', Using the internet to research a topic (Brazil) ending in a short presentation.

Numeracy:

- Number: multiplication and division (sharing, equal parts, dividing by 2 and 5)
- Statistics (exploring graphs)
- Geometry: properties of 2D and 3D shapes (vertices, edges, faces, corners and sides).

PSHE (Science link):

This half term will explore healthy lifestyles. We will look at:
healthy food choices, the importance of exercise and how to keep clean and why it is important to do so.

Religious Education:
