


**Literacy:**  
 We will be examining calligrams and shape poetry, thinking about how to be creative with the layout of poetry as well as improving our descriptive writing. We will produce our own shape poems on superheroes.

We will then look at how comics and graphic novels depict the heroes and villains in their stories. We will examine the speech, language and illustrations used in these texts before creating a character profile for our own superheroes and villains and including them in our own comic superhero stories.

**Science:**  
 Magnets and Springs:

Linking the idea of forces to superheroes, we will revisit our learning on pushes and pulls. We will explore different magnets and investigate magnetic materials, learning about the poles, attraction and repulsion in the process. We will then look at springs and where they are used. We will investigate the strength of different springs and which forces are involved in their use.



**Design and technology:**  
 Moving villains:  
 We will look at various villains from superhero stories. Then we will look at how simple pneumatic systems can be used to produce movement and design a model of a villain with moving parts. We will make these models, focusing on joining and assembling components precisely before evaluating our models.

 Addition and subtraction of two and three digit numbers, using mental and more formal written methods. Using place value to multiply and divide by 10 and multiples of 10. Measuring Length and Perimeter (cm, m and mm). Representing, comparing and ordering fractions of shapes and numbers.
