Details of the Pupil Premium allocation

Pupil Premium Funding is in addition to main school funding. It is allocated to address the current underlying inequalities between children eligible for free school meals (FSM) and Children Looked After (CLA) and their peers, by ensuring that funding to tackle disadvantage reaches the pupils who need it most.

We were allocated £33,019 for the current financial year (2012-13) and used the funds to support pupils in the following ways.

- Tutoring in Maths and English
- Booster groups in English and Maths
- Intervention groups
- Additional support in class
- Educational visits and experiences
- Family support worker (1 day a week)
- Additional Speech and Language Therapist visits
- Additional Education Psychologist visits

What impact did this have for our Pupil Premium children in 2012 - 2013?

100% of FSM & CLA pupils supported by Pupil Premium achieved expected progress at Key Stage 2 in Reading.

83% FSM & CLA pupils supported by Pupil Premium achieved expected progress at Key Stage 2 in Writing

100% FSM & CLA pupils supported by Pupil Premium achieved expected progress at Key Stage 2 in Maths

Future spending of Pupil Premium funding

We have been allocated £54,000 for the current financial year (2013-2014) and plan to use it:

- Additional teaching and learning support
- Family support worker
- Pupil premium resources may also be used to target able children on FSM to excel
- To help with the residential trip costs for vulnerable Y6 pupils
- Subsidising the cost of trips that are planned throughout the year
- One to one/ small group specific support provided by teachers
- To provide short term intervention programmes for vulnerable pupils and those with SEN
- Providing extra curricular clubs for pupils
- Financial support for out of hours activities
