

Pupil Premium Funding

What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium is additional funding allocated to pupils entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), Looked After Children (LAC) and children from Forces families. The funding is given to allow schools to put measures in place to close the gap between these children and their peers.

The allocation in financial year 2015/2016 is £1300 per child.

Tutoring	To enable targeted children to achieve end of year targets Cost: £8000	
Additional phonics teaching	To provide additional phonics support for pupils throughout the school Annual: £2000	
Beanstalk Reading Volunteers Targeted pupils	To support reading £500	
Music therapist	To employ a music therapist to provide therapy/counselling for vulnerable pupils £6000
