Attendance during Co-vid 19

At this time of year it is very common for children to get a cold and other bugs. We understand that with Covid-19 things will be different.

If children have symptoms such as a sore throat, stomach upset or headache they can remain off school as normal and return when they are well enough.

Covid- 19 Symptoms

If children or a member of the household have a **high temperature, new continuous cough or loss of taste or smell** they must isolate at home, along with all family members. A test can be booked by calling 119 or through the website Nhs.uk/coronavirus

If the test result is negative the child can return to school.

If a test is not taken the person who is displaying the symptoms will have to isolate for 10 days after the day of onset and the rest of the household will need to isolate for 14 days.
